## FEC ISSUES FIRST DETAILED PRESIDENTIAL REPORT

WASHINGTON — Twelve 1984 Presidential campaigns raised \$30.1 million and spent \$27.2 million before the start of the election year, according to a Report issued by the Federal Election Commission. Prior to the 1980 Presidential campaign year, 14 campaigns had raised \$39.1 million and spent \$35.8 million.

The FEC Report, entitled FEC Reports on Financial Activity, 1983-1984, Interim Report No. 1, Presidential Pre-Nomination Campaigns, is the first of a series which will present in detail, the financial activity of all Presidential campaigns which have exceeded \$100,000. Interim reports will be issued regularly as the campaign cycle proceeds. The final report will be issued in early 1985, including activity from the start of each campaign through December 31, 1984.

This Report differs from the monthly Presidential Campaign Summary Reports in that it presents a more detailed analysis of the campaigns' financial standings through a given point in time. Comparisons can be made with interim reports issued for similar time periods for the 1980 Presidential primaries.

A summary of figures in the FEC study show that:

- \* 12 candidates raised \$30.1 million;
- \* Of the total raised, \$25.7 million, or 85.3% came from contributions from individuals;
- \* Loans received by the candidates which were still unpaid as of December 31, 1983, totalled \$3.5 million, or 11.6% of the total raised;
- \* Contributions from PAC's and other committees comprised 2.9% of the total funds raised, or \$.9 million;
- \* The campaigns spent \$27.2 million, of which \$25.1 million was subject to overall limits, including fundraising exemptions.

The first FEC Presidential Interim Report includes financial tables and graphs describing the various sources of monies raised by the campaigns. The study delineates the distribution of individual contributions - large or small - and distinguishes between the types of PAC money given to each

candidate, along with the time periods when the monies were contributed. Additional tables provide information on the spending allocated to individual states by each candidate, and the amount of large individual contributions flowing to the campaigns from each state.

Another table details independent expenditures and communications costs by individuals, PAC's, corporations, unions, and delegate committees on behalf of candidates. A final chart shows the net financial picture of individual campaigns for each reporting period throughout the campaign.

A summary of the information available is provided on the next page.
